The Langton Language Centre (LLC) would like to offer an amazing opportunity to our Year 13 students to study for a Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL) course all day on **Friday 7th and Saturday 8th October 22.**

This fast-paced and engaging course, run by UK-TEFL, gives students everything they need to take their first steps into EFL teaching. The course will include icebreakers, sample lessons (designed to put students in the position of English learners), a grammar recap, valuable teaching techniques, tips on finding work abroad, lesson planning and much more, through the use of fun hands-on activities. Students will even get the opportunity to plan and teach their own lessons each day.

Upon completion of the course, students will be certified to Teach English as a Foreign Language with a TQUK qualification enabling them to teach abroad or privately in the UK.

Why TEFL?

TEFL offers anyone the chance to travel and see the world, gain new experiences, and get paid for it. You can also use the UK-TEFL certificate to teach EFL in the UK through private tuition, work on government literacy schemes or why not become a mentor at your local college or university. For those wishing to further their education at university, the certificate and skills gained from the course can also set students apart when it comes to writing UCAS Personal Statements.
