Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Year 7 Local History Research visit to Canterbury on Friday 9th June 2023.

The History department is excited to offer the whole of Year 7 a visit to historical sites with the purpose of investigating 'unseen' aspects of Medieval Canterbury on Friday 9th June.

The students will be touring the city in groups accompanied by staff. All groups will have a guided tour of the Cathedral and a visit to the archives, which is fascinating for them, as well as a guided tour of Eastbridge Hospital and we will picnic in the Cathedral precincts.

Students should come to school at the normal time for registration and we will then walk down into the town at 9.10am. The students will be dismissed at the bus station at approximately 3.00pm. and those who need to get back to school will be escorted. School uniform will need to be worn with a suitable coat if the weather looks inclement or sun cream if required. They will also need a clipboard and pens / pencils for writing and sketching, and a picnic lunch.

The overall cost of this visit is **£7.75** per student to cover the costs of the Cathedral and Eastbridge Hospital. Please could payment be made via ParentPay system by **Friday 26th May**. The visit will only take place if sufficient funds are collected. Students will attend this visit based on their common consent forms that you have already agreed.
